GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- A flamboyant Gothic church with finely sculpted ornamentation.
- A Museum of Fine Arts showcasing almost 450 works of art.
- A rich programme of cultural events.

The Royal Monastery of Brou is a masterpiece to the love story of Margaret of Austria and her late husband Philibert II, nicknamed the Handsome or the Good.

The church itself houses a profusion of admirable stonework and regal tombs, while the three cloisters with their upper and lower galleries will draw you into the amazing life of the founder and her romantic story, marked by tragedy, politics and love. From the church to the Museum of Fine Arts, travel through several centuries of art history, from the 12th century to the present day, as you admire works from the Low Countries, by 19th-century

artists and by some of the great names in contemporary art.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The only marriage to take place in the church at Brou was that of Robert, Archduke of Austria-Este and Margherita of Savoy-Aosta in 1953, uniting the Houses of Austria and Savoy!
